- The service rebate will be paid out if at least one (1) of the following scenarios occurs as a result of a Singtel network failure or a Singtel equipment failure, and affects all the SIP DDI numbers subscribed by the customer:
 - a. unable to receive incoming calls on any access circuit; and/or
 - b. only one-way voice traffic (e.g. unable to hear the other party or unable to be heard).
